Early English Books Online 란?

- ❖ 영어로 쓰여진 최초의 책과 Spenser & Shakespeare의 시대에서 부터 1700년에 이르기까지 영국에서 출판되거나 영어로 출판된 대부분의 출판물을 포함
- ❖ 이 시기에 관한 유일하고 가장 권위 있는 문헌자료인 Pollard & Redgrave의 Short-Title Catalogue (1475-1640)와 Wing의 Short-Title Catalogue (1641-1700)에 속하는 125,000권에서 1,400만 페이지에 달하는 스캔 이미지 제공
- ❖ 전 세계 200여개 도서관에 분포되어 있는 나머지 고서에 대한 발굴 및 디지털화 작업이 여전히 진행중임
- ❖ 첫 마이크로필름 버전이 출시된 1938년 이후 르네상스시대와 근대 초기를 연구하는데 필요한 유일하고 기념비적인 자료로 자리매김함 : ProQuest(UMI) 최초의 제품이며 여전히 추가적인 콘텐츠 발굴 중

- ❖ 휴머니즘이 재 탄생한 Renaissance 시기에서 출발하여, 교육을 통해 지식이 확산되고, 출판기술이 발달하던 시기를 거쳐, 영국 왕정복고의 시기까지의 모든 출판물을 포함
- ❖ **중요저자** : Spenser, Bacon, More, Erasmus, Shakespeare, Newton, Galileo
- ❖ **문학 및 고전 연구** : 초서의 Canterbury Tales와 Malory의 *Morte d'Arthur*와 같은 고전 문학작품의 원본이 제공되며, 문학전공자라면 Shakespeare 연극의 초기 4절판(quarto)본과 1623의 그 유명한 최초의 2절판본을 비교연구할 수 있다. 또, 이러한 유명한 저자들과 당시의 비교적 알려지지 않은 저자를 비교해서 연구해 보는 것도 유익할 것이다.

Where these have been identified, they are listed under [Manuscripts](#) below. The newspaper collection consists of 395 titles representing over 7,600 issues. Newspapers can be browsed by volume and tract number as they were collected above, or additionally by [Title](#) or by [Date](#), or searched using the [Periodicals Search](#) feature. In addition the entire Thomason Tract collection is fully integrated within Early English Books Online and can be accessed using any of the EEBO search and browse functions.
